Sub: Engagement of Shri Girish Dave, Advocate as Special Counsel to represent Income Tax Department before the Honourable Bombay High Court in writ petition Nos. [WP 2562 of 2015 and 2557 of 2015] filed by the Department against the order of ITSC u/s 245D(4) dated 28.11.2014 and order u/s. 245D(6B) dated 21.05.2015 in the case of Lodha Developers Pvt Ltd and Others (Lodha Group of cases] - reg.-

2. The Department had engaged Shri Kevic Setalwad, [Senior advocate and former Additional Solicitor General] and his Juniors to represent the Department at that stage. But due to some reasons Shri Kevic Setalvad has expressed his inability to continue with the brief vide letter dated 31.07.2018 Addressed to the Pr.CIT-Central-4.
3. The undersigned had discussed the matter with Shri Girish Dave, Advocate and Shri N. C. Mohanty, Advocate, who are engaged to argue the case along with Shri Kevic Setalvad[Senior advocate and former Additional Solicitor General]. They were of the opinion that in the light of Shri Kevic Setalvad's unwillingness to continue the brief, the revenue should engage Shri.Anil C. Singh, Senior Advocate, Additional Solicitor General of India, Government of Maharashtra. Consequently a proposal to this intent was moved by the undersigned vide letter dated 02.08.2018 {No.DCIT(CC)7(3)/Setl.Com/Lodha/Writ/ASG/}
